

Continuing Eligibility for OTC Scholarships

Ouachita Technical College Academic Scholarship Requirements

What the scholarship covers:

The award will be disbursed for the Fall and Spring terms provided you are enrolled in at least 12 semester hours for Fall and 15 semester hours for subsequent terms. **The scholarship will pay for mandatory tuition and fees. Lab fees, special course fees, and the matriculation fees are the student's responsibility.** The scholarship will not pay the tuition and fees for repeated courses.

This scholarship is awarded for the duration of four consecutive semesters or the completion of an associate degree, whichever comes first, provided the student maintains all scholarship requirements.

Scholarship requirements:

1. Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.
2. Successfully complete 27 semester hours per academic year (Fall term through summer terms). Classes in which an "F, AU, W, or I" is received will not count towards these hours. Repeated courses will not be counted in completed hours. Students may use summer terms to complete the required hours or GPA but the scholarship does not pay for summer terms.
3. Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Developmental courses will be counted in the grade point average.
4. If the cumulative GPA falls below a 3.00 but is at least a 2.75, the scholarship will be reduced to pay for tuition only.

Ouachita Technical College Merit Scholarship Requirements

What the scholarship covers:

The award will be disbursed for the Fall and Spring terms provided you are enrolled in at least 12 semester hours for Fall and 15 semester hours for subsequent terms. **The scholarship will pay for tuition. Fees are the student's responsibility.** The scholarship will not pay the tuition for repeated courses.

This scholarship is awarded for the duration of four consecutive semesters or the completion of an associate degree, whichever comes first, provided the student maintains all scholarship requirements.

Scholarship requirements:

1. Be enrolled in a program that leads to a certificate or associate degree.
2. Successfully complete 27 semester hours per academic year (Fall term through summer terms). Classes in which an "F, AU, W, or I" is received will not count towards these hours. OTC Non-traditional Scholarship Requirements

OTC Foundation Scholarship

What the scholarship covers:

The award will be \$500 for the Fall semester provided you are enrolled as a full time student. The scholarship can pay for tuition, fees, or books.

Scholarship requirements:

1. Be enrolled in a certificate or associate degree program.
2. The scholarship will renew for an additional \$500 for the Spring semester provided you are enrolled full time, maintain satisfactory progress, and have a cumulative grade point average of a 2.5.
3. Complete at least nine credit hours in the Fall term. Classes in which an "F, AU, W, or I" is received will not count towards these hours. Repeated courses will not be counted in completed hours.
